

Golf Tee Card Quickie Instructions

SUPPLIES

Stamps: Wild West Alphabet, Just Golf

Inks: Basic Black, Sahara Sand, Old Olive

Papers: 5" x 2" Night of Navy, 12" x 5" Old Olive,
1 3/8" x 3" Whisper White, 1.5" x 3 1/8" Basic Black

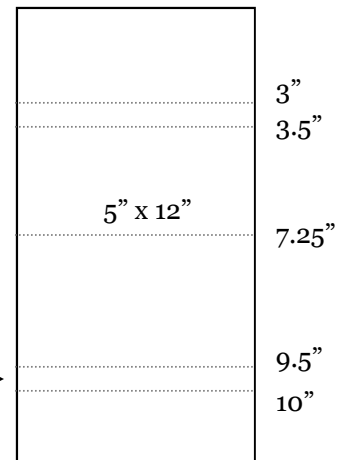
Other: Small Buckle from Hodgepodge Hardware, Chocolate Chip Polytwill, 3/8" Hole Punch

MAKING THE CARD

1. Start with a piece of 12" x 5" Old Olive Cardstock
2. Score at 3", 3.5", 7.25", 9.5", and 10"
3. Punch 3/8" holes for golf tees, leaving 1/2" to 3/4" between each hole (on my card there are six holes, about 5/8" apart, starting approximately 7/8" in from either side)

Complete all stamping before assembling the card.

Punch 3/8" holes for tees →



STAMPING & ASSEMBLY

1. Stamp "FORE" in Old Olive across the card three times (Hint: begin with the center one and use the Stamp-a-ma-jig to place the other two)
2. Stamp the Golf Club using Old Olive
3. Wrap Chocolate Chip Polytwill around the Night of Navy Cardstock and adhere the ends to the back
4. Tie another piece of Chocolate Chip Polytwill through the buckle (tie twice) and adhere over the original piece of polytwill using a glue dot
5. Adhere the Night of Navy Cardstock
6. Stamp "DAD" on Whisper White using Basic Black and color in using a Blender Pen and Sahara Sand.
7. Adhere the Whisper White to the Basic Black mat and adhere this, over the polytwill, onto the Night of Navy.
8. Fold the card and adhere to hold the golf tees.
