SUPPLIES

Stamps: Ginormous Blooms

Inks: Purely Pomegranate, Soft Sky, Blue Bayou

Other: Flower Ribbon Slides from Styled Silver Hodgepodge Hardware, Soft Sky Double Stitched Ribbon, White Grosgrain Ribbon, 1 1/4" Circle Punch, Scallop Circle Punch, Sakura White Gel Pen, Crystal Effects/Tombow Multipurpose Adhesive, Dazzling Diamonds, Stampin Dimensionals, Glue Dots, Dimensional Glue Dots, Bamboo Skewers, Dollar Bills, Floral Foam, Silver Bucket (Ikea), Green Shredded Paper

How to . . .

1. Pick a floral stamp set, round stamped images or something you can stamp and then punch with a circle punch, and then use the Scallop Circle Punch to make it into a flower. So make your flowers!
2. Embellish to your hearts desire!
3. Attach your flowers to bamboo skewers using Dimensional Glue Dots



What I actually did was punch a Scallop Circle from Whisper White, put two Dimensional Glue Dots on, almost touching each other, put the skewer in between them, then added my flower on top.

If you plan to give this as a gift and you'd like a more finished look on the back of the flower replace the Scallop Circle with a second stamped image.

4. Add dollar bills to the skewer. Accordion fold or squish the dollar bill in the center, lay under the skewer and tightly tie the ribbon.
5. Place floral foam in container, add flowers and paper grass.
